

Cook-Off Competition Policies

1. All teams are responsible for having a good time and promoting a safe and festive environment.
2. Spaces will be chosen on a first come/first serve basis, so get your entries in EARLY!! We have some great spaces...trees...near the pond. Teams who participated in the Fire and Ice Cook-Off in the past will have first right of refusal on their space. **PLEASE NOTE: To retain spaces from past cookoffs, entry fees must be paid by September 30th, 2007. Fees paid later will be accepted, but your same space may not still be available.**
3. All spaces will be 40' X 40'. All team equipment, fences, facades, tents, etc. must be inside the assigned spaces. You can reserve as many spaces as you need.
4. **ALL VEHICLES MUST BE OUT OF THE COOK-OFF AREA BETWEEN 6:00 PM AND MIDNIGHT FRIDAY AND NOON AND MIDNIGHT ON SATURDAY. 4-WHEELERS WILL NOT BE ADMITTED WITHOUT EXPRESS PERMISSION (only for special circumstances).**
5. Open fires will be permitted, subject to current fire hazard conditions. Open fires must be controlled and maintained in a safe condition for the protection of team members and the public. Dead wood on the grounds may be used, but no live trees may be cut. Unsafe fires or conditions will not be allowed.
6. Each booth must have two (2) BC fire extinguishers and we strongly recommend a first aid kit.
7. Music must conform to local noise ordinances at required hours.
8. Meat will be tagged at the cook's meeting (or on arrival for those unable to attend The cook's meeting). **COOK'S MEETING WILL BE HELD ON THURSDAY AT 7:00 PM. MOVE-IN WILL BE FROM THURSDAY 9:00 AM TO FRIDAY AT 6:00 PM.** (Meat not tagged at the cook's meeting may be tagged at the outdoor kitchen area. Food containers for competition entries may also be picked up there.
9. Proper food handling procedures must be followed to insure safe and sanitary conditions and products.
10. Security and safety are the sole responsibility of all teams and members. The ICEWORKS, THE SILVER STAR RANCH, the benefitting charity and or Jay/Carol Maclaskey are not responsible for the theft of or damage to the property of teams, team members or guests thereof. Each team is also responsible for the safety of their team members and guests while on the cook-off grounds.
11. Alcoholic beverages distributed by teams to team members and guests must be in compliance with all pertinent laws. Teams are responsible for team members and guest's conduct. Excessive use of alcohol or unacceptable conduct may be grounds for disqualification or removal from the grounds. Under no circumstances may alcoholic beverages be served to minors. Teams are responsible to keep their guests safe and from harm. **PLEASE DON'T DRINK AND DRIVE!!!**
12. All teams and members must comply with all pertinent laws and ordinances.
13. Be aware and respectful of livestock on the property.
14. All spaces must be left in a clean and orderly condition.
